

AUDITION & TECHNICAL INTERVIEW INFORMATION & EXPECTATIONS

Any Germantown High School student who would like to audition and/or participate in a technical interview for the 2019 fall Performing Arts must observe the following guidelines:

- The student must have a parent/legal guardian present at the mandatory parents meeting, which will be held at the beginning of the 2018-2019 school year. Parents will be notified of this date in the fall. If a parent is unable to attend this meeting, he or she should contact Mrs. Summerlin directly.
- The student must return a completed application packet (keep this page for your information) by the end of the school day on **Wednesday**, **April 24th**.
- The student must have two teachers complete and return evaluations to Mrs. Summerlin by **Wednesday**, **April 24th**. It is the student's job to give the blank evaluation forms to their teachers in time for them to complete and return the forms by the **24th**.
- Auditions will be held in the GHS cafetorium on Wednesday, April 24th. From 4:00 pm until approximately 6:00 p.m. Students will be asked to sign-in upon arrival and appointments will be conducted in order of arrival. If a student has a conflict and needs an early appointment, please notify Mrs. Summerlin in writing (or via email at esummerlin@madison-schools.com) before Wednesday, April 24th. No auditions and/or interviews will be conducted after this date.
- On the day of the audition, the student must present himself or herself to the judges in an appropriate, businesslike manner. Students may choose to be considered for an acting position and/or a technical position. Requirements for those positions are outlined below.
 - o Students who would like to be considered as actors must prepare a one-minute monologue from a contemporary play. This selection must be memorized, and students may find monologues either on their own or on the Maverick Theatre website (www.madison-schools.com/mavericktheatre) under the "Theatre Documents" tab.
 - Students who would like to be considered for technical positions will participate in a technical interview, complete a skills application, and perform a technical analysis/design mock-up for a given scene.
- Students who have participated in a previous Maverick Theatre production will have these accomplishments considered in their audition score, but all students who want to participate in the fall 2019 class will be expected to complete the audition/interview process.
- Audition results regarding the 2019-2020 Performing Arts class will be posted outside Mrs. Summerlin's classroom (Room 402) and on the Maverick Theatre website (www.madison-schools.com/mavericktheatre) no later than **Friday, May 5th.**
