Socially Distanced Service Ideas

- 1 Write encouraging chalk messages on the sidewalks at nursing homes (if permitted).
- 2 Distribute leaf bags and offer to assist neighbors with raking their yards
- 3 Create a compilation of online videos to share on the school website or Facebook with encouraging words, quotes, or songs
- 4 Gather newspapers and give to a local animal shelter to line their floors
- 5 Start a Chow Drive for the community to donate food and toys to a local shelter. You can organize with a sign up, and ask people to leave their items on doorsteps for you to pick up.
- 6 Make videos of reading books online for the primary students
- 7 Call local nonprofits to find out current needs in your community
- 8 Paint the window of a local small business to show love and support (if permitted)
- 9 Donate gently used clothing to a local charity in your area
- 10 Volunteer to read books or newspapers over the phone to those who are visually impaired
- 11 Host a yard sale with your family and donate the money to a food drive organization
- 12 Create goody bags of snacks to deliver to kids in your school/district
- 13 Create holiday themed place mats for your local senior citizen home
- 14 Gather combs, toothbrushes, shampoo, razors, etc. to make "I Care" kits for people who are homeless
- 15 Donate used books to your local children's shelter/women's home
- 16 Organize a songfest and perform outside the windows of a nursing home
- 17 Plant a community garden
- 18 Build a ramp for a person in a wheelchair to make their house more accessible
- 19 Adopt a "grandfriend." Write them letters, call them, and send goodies to their residence
- 20 Offer dog-walking services to those who can't give their pets the proper amount of exercise
- 21 Send care packages to deployed military
- 22 Decorate Kindness Rocks and leave inspiring messages in a garden or park
- 23 Organize a hike or nature walk (if you're able to in your area) and bring bags to collect trash along the trails
