### **ACADEMICS:**

- ♦ You must be enrolled in Geometry or a higher mathematics class.
- ♦ You must be currently enrolled in a math class.
- ♦ You must have an **overall** B average in your **math** classes beginning with Algebra 1. It is possible to be eligible if you had a "C" in **one** class.

## **SERVICE HOURS:**

♦ You must complete 10 service hours. 2 of these hours must be in tutoring.

## DUES:

\$30 This includes your school, state, and national dues and a t-shirt.

## **MEETINGS:**

- ♦ RHS Mu Alpha Theta meeting will be held once a month.
- ♦ Math Competition practice may be held if these become available. Local and State Competitions are a unique way to challenge and express yourself in the mathematics world. Because of COVID these may not be possible this year. I encourage you to consider participating if these become available.
