HOW TO FIND OUT ABOUT BOOKS IN THE LIBRARY - DESTINY DISCOVER

The software we use to search our database of books (Follett Destiny) is called Destiny Discover.

The easiest way to get to Destiny
Discover is to start at the Library
Home Page which you can get to
by going to www.otmstitans.com
You will see a link for Destiny
Discover

In Destiny Discover, you will see a curated page that groups certain collections of books. Some collections are: Recently Added Books (we have a book subscription that sends about ten books per month. We also order a large shipment of books about three times per school year.) The curated page also has books by topic and books that are the most popular. Come tell the librarian a little about the word curated or curator and I will give you Titan Cash for Learning Actively.

The main thing to do in Destiny Discover is to search for books in the library. If you have the question: Ms. McGraw, do you have (insert the book title you are looking for), then you can search that title in Destiny Discover. If you wonder if your favorite book is in the library or checked out, you can search the book and see if it is available. To find a fiction book in the library, you need to know the author's name. You can find the author's name and the book's call number in Destiny Discover.

SORA AND CLEVER...A CLEVER COMBINATION FOR ONLINE BOOKS



The app or software that is used to access OTM Library's great selection of online ebooks and audiobooks is SORA by Overdrive. You can go to www.soraapp.com or download the SORA app. But the easiest way is to access the District's new Clever app by going to www.clever.com or downloading the app. Clever is a Single-Sign-On Service (thanks to Ms. Holden for teaching me that one) and manages the many sign-ons students have. Once in Clever, the SORA app is easy to log in to. The SORA app also has a curated page (what does that mean?) It shows Series Starters, Books that became a Movie, Books by type or Genre, and other collections. Parents, encourage your students to have a hands-on real book and a hands-on or ears-on digital book.
