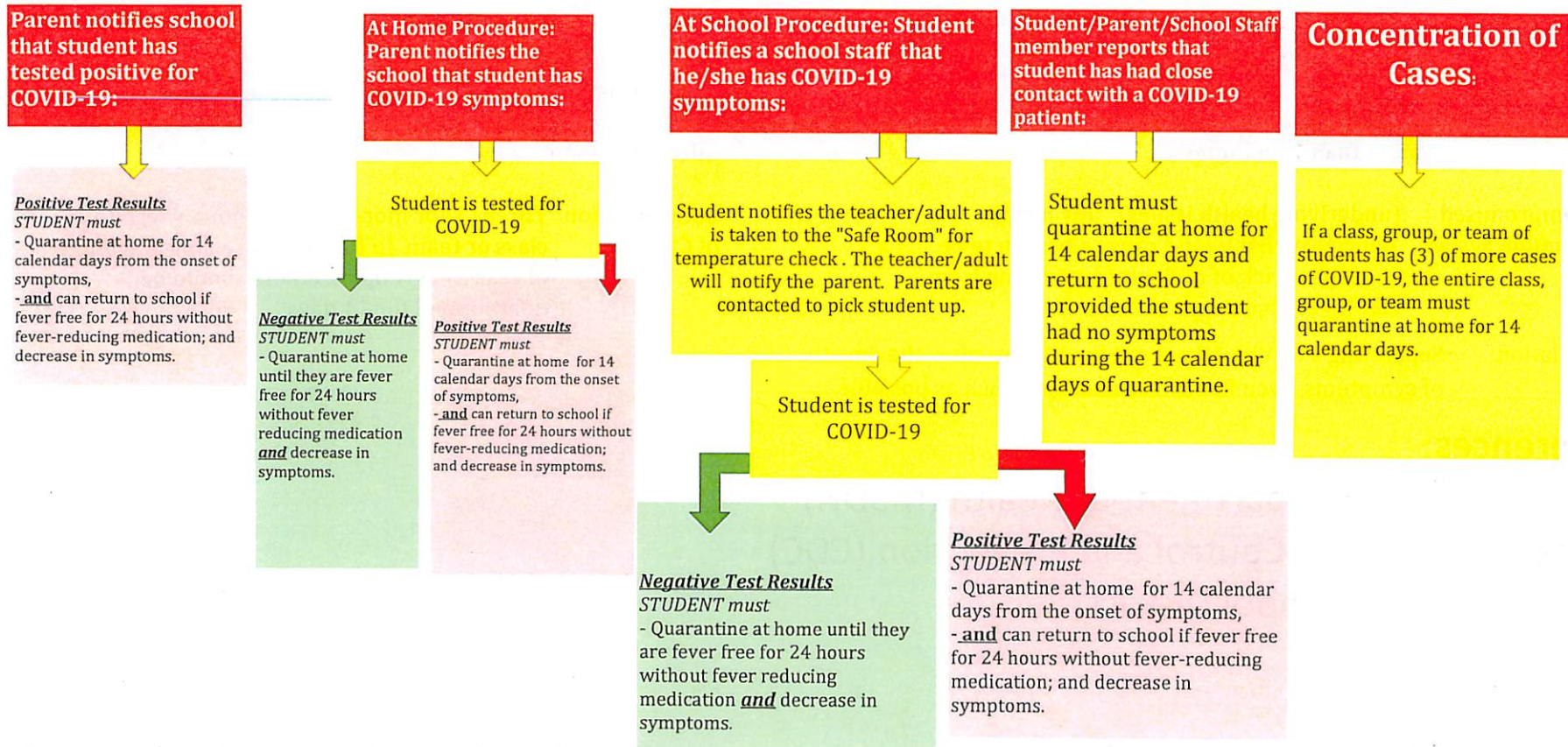


**Madison County Schools COVID-19 Response

Guidelines



If a parent/guardian refuses to have the student tested, then we must assume and follow the Positive Test Results protocol.

Note: Student absences for COVID-19 related issues will **NOT** count against the student's attendance record.

Madison County Schools COVID-19 Response

Definitions:

Close Contact: Exposure that is < 6 feet, for more than 15 minutes

Compromised Immune System: (underlying health issues): any health deficiency that would cause a person to be at a higher risk of difficulty recovering from COVID-19 if contracted.

Isolation: Separating a COVID-19 patient for 14 days after the onset of symptoms, even family members as much as possible.

Quarantine: Staying away from all people as much as possible for 14 days after close contact with a COVID-19 infected person.

Concentration of Cases: Three (3) or more cases within any group, class or team. In the event of a concentration of cases all group members should be quarantined for 14 days .
