2. Each 1st and 2nd grader will score proficient or advanced on the CASE 21 ELA & MATH Assessment


3. Each student will read at the grade-level exit requirement for promotion





4. Each student will master at least 80% of the skills listed on the report card.








MAE Rules and Procedures:
