## Parking Lot Rules and Procedures

### 2024 – 2025

We must have the cooperation of everyone in order to provide the safest and fairest campus possible. Everyone must remember that driving to school is not a right and that the privilege of driving can be lost by failing to follow the rules that are set. Being responsible for your actions and safe driving will ensure safety for everyone.

1. Students with assigned spots are to park only in those spots. The decal that you receive tells which spot is yours. The decal must be visibly displayed on the rear-view mirror of the vehicle. If you switch vehicles, you must remember to put your decal in the vehicle you are driving.
2. Parking is to be in designated areas only.
3. All students are to get out of the vehicles immediately upon arrival on campus and move to designated areas of the building or campus. Do not wait for a monitor to tell you get out of the vehicle.
4. Reckless driving and not following instructions of traffic monitors will result in immediate loss of driving privileges.
5. Disobedience or disrespect with parking lot monitors will result in a disciplinary referral and could result in ISD, OSS, or loss of driving privileges.
6. If someone is in your spot, get the decal number, tag number and spot number. Report to the Front Office to complete the appropriate form.
7. Pull forward into spaces – do not back into space.
8. Driving offenses will be dealt with in the following manner:
  - a. Parking in non-assigned space or other illegal parking \$10.00
  - b. Parking in handicapped space, fire zone or no decal \$10.00
  - c. Lost or stolen decal - \$5.00 replacement fee
  - d. Multiple offenses could result in a discipline referral

Student Drug Testing Consent Form**

**Statement of Purpose and Intent**

Participation in school-sponsored extracurricular activities and driving on campus in the schools of the Madison County School District is a privilege. Activity Students and Student Drivers have a responsibility to themselves, their fellow students, their schools, their families, and their community to set the highest possible examples of conduct by avoiding the use or possession of illegal or performance-enhancing drugs.

Drug use of any kind is incompatible with participation in extracurricular activities and for driving a vehicle on school campuses in the Madison County School District. For the safety, health, and well being of all students, Madison County Schools has adopted a policy of using an independent testing laboratory to conduct random drug testing of all students at middle schools and high schools in the District who participate in certain extracurricular activities, whether or not the activity is in off season or in season (an "Activity Student"), and students who purchase a parking decal/permit to drive on campus (a "Student Driver").

**Participation in Extra-Curricular Activities**

Each Activity Student or Student Driver shall be given a copy of the Student Random Drug Testing Policy and Student Drug Testing Consent Form. Both the student and the student's parent or legal guardian must read, sign, and date the Student Drug Testing Consent Form before the student shall be eligible to practice or participate in the listed extracurricular activity or purchase a parking decal/permit to drive on campus. To be eligible to participate in or practice with certain extracurricular activities or to purchase a parking decal/permit to drive on campus, the consent shall be (a) to give a urine sample; (b) if chosen on a random selection basis; or (c) at any time requested based on reasonable suspicion of the use or possession of illegal or performance-enhancing drugs. No student shall be allowed to practice or participate in any activity governed by this policy or to purchase a parking decal/permit unless the student has returned the properly signed Student Drug Testing Consent Form.

We desire that the student named above participate in the extracurricular activities of Madison County Schools and/or be allowed to drive on campus, and we hereby voluntarily agree that our child or ward and we are subject to terms of the Student Random Drug Testing Policy. We accept the method of obtaining urine samples, testing and analysis of such specimens, and all other aspects of the policy. We further authorize the independent testing laboratory adopted by Madison County Schools to disclose all drug testing lab results and related information for the child named in this consent form to Madison County Schools for the purpose as provided in the policies and procedures adopted by the District for the voluntary drug test program. We understand that we may revoke this authorization at any time by written notice to the District and the independent testing laboratory. We acknowledge that any such revocation will not be effective as to any disclosures made prior to receiving such revocation. I understand that any information disclosed by the independent test laboratory under this authorization may no longer be protected by federal privacy regulations, and that such information may be further disclosed by the recipient. We understand that this authorization will become effective immediately upon execution and shall remain in effect until the student named in this consent form is no longer subject to the Drug Testing Policy of Madison County Schools. We further agree and consent to the disclosure of the sampling, testing and results as provided in the policy and any regulation adopted by the administration of the District.
