Dear Parents,

Governor Reeves has declared a shelter in place order to begin at 5 p.m. on Friday, April 3, 2020, for the state of Mississippi. In accordance with that order, Madison County Schools will modify several current programs while we continue to serve our students through distance learning.

Packets of distance learning materials for your child to work on during the next two weeks will be available at each campus by noon on Friday so that you may pick up your child's packet prior to the shelter in place order taking effect. During the shelter in place order, please do not return any completed learning packets to your child's school as originally planned. Those completed packets will be collected at a later time.

Our technology department is creating a call center to assist with your technology needs. With the capability either to take over district device screens remotely or talk users through troubleshooting issues, our tech experts should be able to provide help even from a distance. As soon as the call center is up and running, which should be shortly, we will provide contact information and details on our website. Once the shelter in place order takes effect, we are suspending all on-site technology assistance.

Pick up meal service also will be modified once the shelter in place order takes effect: meal packs to cover multiple days will be offered at all current meal distribution sites for pick up on Tuesdays and Thursdays only. This plan will not affect meal service on April 2 and 3, but the changes will take effect for the upcoming week.

Thank you for your patience and understanding as we all adapt to these changing circumstances. As always, we love your children and miss them in our schools. Please heed the order to shelter in place and stay safe.
