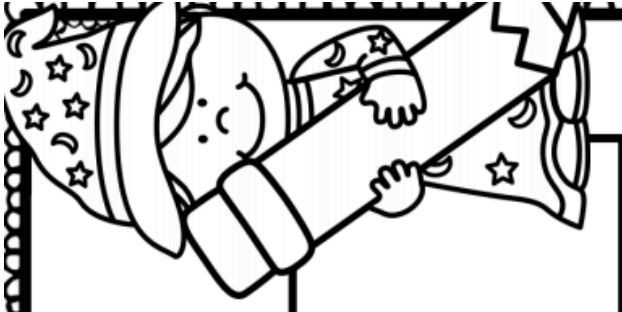


## Lesson
