

COVID-19 INFORMATION

This page is designed to keep community members aware of the latest MCS reports of COVID-19 cases and numbers in quarantine. This information is also reported on a weekly basis to the Mississippi Department of Health. The number of positive cases reported includes students and staff testing positive for COVID-19 during the specified timeframe. For your reference, Madison County Schools has approximately 14,500 total staff and students.

Each time we are notified of a positive case, administrators will conduct contact tracing. If it is determined your child has been in close contact with a positive case, you will be personally notified and provided quarantine instructions. Close contact is defined by the Mississippi Department of Health as being within 6 feet (or 3 feet in a classroom setting) of a person for more than 15 minutes. If a child in your student's class has tested positive, but close contact has not taken place, you will be informed to monitor for symptoms. Please see the Covid-19 Decision Tree for Students in the MCS Reentry Guidelines for more details.

Information provided below includes only Madison County Schools students, faculty, and staff. Madison County numbers reported by MSDH include totals for all schools in the county, both public and private, as well as the Canton School District.

Weekly counts are updated on the first school day of the week by the end of the day.
