



Madison Central Reserved Parking Guidelines

1. Every MC student who parks on campus must purchase a parking decal. All parking spaces have numbers and every student's parking space number will match their student ID and decal #. This is being done for the safety of our students and faculty and will allow administrators to quickly identify those vehicles parked on campus daily.
2. As in previous years, PTO membership is not a requirement to purchase a parking decal. **Parking decals are \$35.** If you are not joining the PTO, you will be able to purchase and select your spot at schedule pick up on a first-come, first-serve basis.
3. The timeline for joining the PTO, purchasing your decal and spot selection will be as follows:
 - May 8-July 12** Website opens for purchase of PTO membership and Parking Decal
 - July 10 & 12** 8:00 – 12:00 noon – PTO board members will be taking cash and check payments in the auditorium at MC
 - July 12** Deadline to join PTO (online) and purchase your parking decal for summer spot selection.
 - July 17** Seniors who have purchased any level of PTO membership & Decal (Front Lot Only)
 - July 18** Juniors who have purchased any level of PTO membership & Decal (Back Lot Only)
 - July 19** Sophomores who have purchased any level of PTO membership & Decal (Back Lot Only)
 - July 23** Website closes for selecting parking spots
 - August 1 & 2** Any student who wishes to purchase a parking pass only and not join the PTO will purchase their decal and select their space on a first-come/first serve basis at this time.
4. Seniors will be the only students allowed to choose parking spaces in the front lot of the school as it will remain a parking privilege for them. Juniors and Sophomores will select parking spaces in the back lot only.
5. The school administration will be monitoring the parking lot to ensure that all students are parked in their assigned spot. If a student is parked in a spot that is not theirs, they will receive an office referral that could include both disciplinary actions as well as a loss of exemption privileges.
6. There are no other PTO fundraisers for our school. Funds collected from the sale of parking decals and PTO memberships generate the financial support for our students and teachers that PTO has provided and will continue to provide each year.
