- **Recommendation Letter #1:** Must be from the school guidance counselor and include the applicant's GPA and ACT scores. The envelope should be sealed and signed by the counselor.
- **Recommendation Letter #2:** Must be from a teacher or school administrator.
- **Recommendation Letter #3:** Must be from an individual in the community, church, employer, etc., who is well acquainted with the applicant.

I certify that all information provided in this application is accurate and complete to the best of my knowledge. I understand that providing false or misleading information in any part of this application or in any supporting documentation may result in disqualification from the selection process. Additionally, I understand that if I am selected for the scholarship and do not attend an HBCU, I will forfeit the scholarship offered by the National Coalition of 100 Black Women, Inc., Central Mississippi Chapter.
