- Recommendation Letter #1: Must be from the school guidance counselor and include the applicant's GPA and ACT scores. The envelope should be sealed and signed by the counselor.
- Recommendation Letter #2: Must be from a teacher or school administrator.
- Recommendation Letter #3: Must be from an individual in the community, church, employer, etc., who is well acquainted with the applicant.

I understand that providing false or misleading information in any part of this application or in any supporting documentation may result in disqualification from the selection process.
