Art:

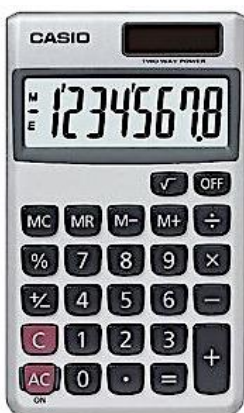
- Art fee of \$15 per art student

All Math students: Must purchase a BASIC 4-function calculator. No scientific or graphing calculators are allowed in 7th grade math.

Algebra 1 students: Students who are enrolled in Algebra 1 are recommended but not required to purchase a **TI-83 or TI-84 calculator**. These are the calculators that will be used on the Algebra 1 state test.

HISTORY:

ICT:

- Ear buds or headphones - bring every day (will be used in **EVERY** class)
- Half-inch binder
- 1 pkg. AA batteries

SCIENCE:

- 1 PACKAGE OF COLORED PENCILS

- 1 PKG. COLORED PRINTER PAPER

LANGUAGE ARTS:

- 1 fat glue stick
