Music	<ul> <li>Students will wear face coverings.</li> <li>Students will hand sanitize before and after Music.</li> <li>Students will social distance to the extent practicable when singing and/or playing instruments.</li> </ul>

PTO Meetings	<ul> <li>PTO meetings, which will only include the Board members, will be held in the Media Center, or they will be held virtually or by phone.</li> <li>The PTO Board will wear face coverings and will practice social distancing to the extent practicable.</li> </ul>
How will you train and continually remind parents and students of appropriate health protocols (social distancing, hand washing, wearing masks, etc.)	<ul> <li>Teachers will review procedures every morning in the classroom as well as remind students by redirecting them when they do not follow the procedures.</li> <li>Parents will be reminded by teachers and administration via class newsletters or the Remind App.</li> <li>Signs will be posted in highly visible locations (e.g., school entrances, restrooms) that promote every day protective measures and describe how to stop the spread of germs (such as by properly washing hands and properly wearing a cloth face covering).</li> <li>Principal or designee will use the PA system to broadcast regular announcements on reducing the spread of COVID-19.</li> <li>School personnel will include messages about behaviors that</li> </ul>

	prevent the spread of COVID-19 when communicating with staff and families (such as on school websites, in emails, and on school social media accounts).
