## Description

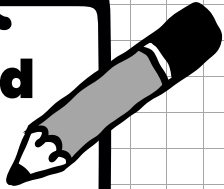
This course provides students with an overview of African American history. The class begins with ancient Africa and progresses chronologically through the late 20th century.
