parade

(n) - a long series of people or things that come one after the other A long **parade** of cars slowly made their way out of the parking lot.

irreparable

(adj) - too bad to be corrected or repaired

The landslide left our house **irreparable**; we will have to build a brand new house from the ground up.

subordinate

(adj) - in a position of less power or authority than someone else; less important

than someone or something else

In the US Army, the ranking of Colonel is **subordinate** to General.

ordinance

(n) - a law or regulation made by a city or town government

The town passed an **ordinance** that prohibited dogs on the beach.

coordinate

(v) - to act or work together properly and well; to cause two or more things to not conflict with or contradict each other

Let's **coordinate** our schedules so while I'm reading, you are using the computer.

inordinate

(adj) - going beyond what is usual, normal, or proper

Waiting for three hours to see the doctor is an inordinate amount of time.

expose

(v) - to leave something without covering or protection; to cause someone to experience something or to be influenced or affected by something; to reveal something hidden or dishonest

Our music teacher felt it was important to **expose** us to many genres of music.

juxtapose

(v) - to place different things together in order to create an interesting effect or to show how they are the same or different

The exhibit will **juxtapose** digital and hand-painted artwork.

posture

(n) - the way in which your body is positioned when you are sitting or standing; the attitude a person or group has toward a subject

It's difficult to keep an upright **posture** after sitting at a desk all day.

repository

(n) - a place where a large amount of something is stored; a person who possesses a lot of information, wisdom, etc.

The university has a repository of research journals that are over 100 years old.
